

Job Description – Healthcare Worker

You will be expected to follow care plans and keep accurate records of the care you provide, as well as monitor and report any changes in health or wellbeing. Working as part of a team, you will liaise with colleagues, families, and healthcare professionals to ensure each person receives the right level of support. Safeguarding, confidentiality, and health and safety must always be upheld.

You will be required to have NVQ Level 2 in Health and Social Care, or equivalent. An enhanced DBS check will be required.
